## THE IMPACT CAN BE DELAYED

the THC in edibles does take longer to affect many people in comparison to smoking or vaping. Digestion takes a little time, causing a delay of up to two hours between consumption and feeling high.

## THEY HAVE A LONG HALF-LIFE

The half-life of cannabis varies, usually falling somewhere in the three- to 12-day window.



## QUANTITY & TOLERANCE IMPACT HALF-LIFE

How long it takes your body to process edibles is impacted by the quantity consumed, as well as whether you're a casual or habitual user.

## MANY TYPES OF DRUG TESTS DETECT EDIBLES

Urine, hair, blood, saliva, and sweat tests can all detect ingested THC. Urine tests are the most common and can detect edibles for up to 30 days. Hair follicle tests can detect the drug for up to 90 days.
