METHADONE

Methadone is a long-acting full opioid agonist primarily used to treat opioid addiction. Because of the risk of addiction, it must be used in a highly controlled medical setting. Source, Source

CHRUNNE

Suboxone is an opioid partial antagonist used as part of MAT treatment for opioid addiction. It offers many practical benefits, particularly for people who need treatment outside a methadone clinic.

NALOXONE

Naloxone opioid is an used to antagonist reverse opioid drug overdose. It may be prescribed as part of medication assisted treatment if a patient is at risk of overdose.

DEA DESIGNATION: NOT CONTROLLED

HALF-LIFE: 30-90 MIN
